## Declaration of Residential Tax and National Health Insurance Tax

### ●Subject Person

- ◇Who had income in 2019, and live in Onojo City as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- ◇Who is a householder of a household which has enrolled in the National Health Insurance.(Kokumin Kenko Hoken)
- ◇Who has enrolled in Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (Koki Koreisha Iryo Hoken)

\*Please declare even in the case of having no income if you need an income certificate or a taxation certificate.

\*if you are employed, please ask your employer if you are a subject person or not.

\*If you submit your final tax return document, you don't need to declare.

### ●Necessary Items

- ◇Documents which certify your income such as Certificate of Pension and withholding tax, Certificate of Income and withholding tax
- ◇Personal Seal
- ◇The documents which certify your insurance premium payment
- ◇Life or (and) Earthquake insurance premium deduction certificate
- ◇My number card or Notification card of your "My Number" and your ID ◇ Document to identify yourself such as a valid driver's license card
- ◇Other certificates (If you would like to apply for other deductions.)

## Consultation of Final Income Tax Return Document

Chikushi Taxation Office accepts only completed documents. If you are aged 65 and older and your income is only pension or salary or your income is both of pension and salary, you can submit the documents at Onojo City Office.

## Have you applied for Persons with Severe Disability Welfare Allowance?

● **Subject Person** Persons with severe disabilities who moved in Onojo City on and before Jan.1<sup>st</sup> in 2019, who have been registered in Onojo City as citizens and who have "Persons with Physical Disabilities Handbook Level1 and Level2" or "Handbook for persons with intellectual disabilities Grade A" during the period of Jan.1<sup>st</sup> to Dec.31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

\* Income restrictions apply

\* The allowance is not paid in any of the following conditions.

- ◇ You are staying at a welfare facility.
- ◇ You are receiving public pension due to your disability.
- ◇ You are receiving other welfare allowance. (Please contact us for details)
- ◇ You were admitted into the hospital for 3 months or more in a row during the period of Jan.1<sup>st</sup> to Dec.31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
- ◇ You have income more than the designated amount.



● **How to Apply** please visit Welfare Section at Onojo City Office and receive the application form

● **Application Deadline** Fri, Jan.31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 (except Sat. and Sun.)

\*The eligible persons should take necessary procedures every January.

## Have you paid the 8<sup>th</sup> period of National Health Insurance Tax?

The deadline of payment of the 8th period of National Health Insurance Tax is Fri, Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>. Delinquent charge will be charged when the payment is overdue. Please make sure to pay by the deadline.

● **Delinquent Charge** 8.9% annually

\*From the next day of the deadline to the day a month passes: 2.6% annually

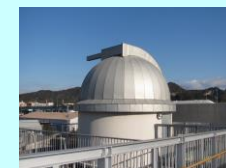
