Please make sure to submit the notification documents at Childrearing Support Section by the deadline.

The Notification has been sent to a subject person at the end of July. If you fall behind in the procedure, you will not be entitled to receive the said medical certificate and aid of October and later months.

Revision of Day-care Fee and Reduction or Exemption of Side Dish Fee of Authorized Nursery Schools in Onojo City

Based on "municipal tax in FY2020", the day-care fee is revised and the side dish fee is reduced or exempted from September. We will contact subject households who need to take the procedure for this.

○Day-care Fee

The day-care fee is decided based on the total amount of municipal taxes in FY2020 (per-income levy) of subject child's parents and the age of the subject child as of April 1st, 2020. For further details, please contact us.

Baby Home Help Service

-We will help women who have just given birth with house work and infant rearing-

Do you know "Baby Home Help Service"? This is a system to support healthy baby rearing and reduce physical and mental burdens of parents by sending home helpers to households which have difficulties in everyday lives due to mother's health problem, and giving necessary help regarding house work and child rearing.

●Subjects

Those who live in Onojo City with a baby of 12 weeks old or less and who are unable to have support on childcare or housework from family.

●Content of services

- ◆Childcare : bathing, changing diapers, feeding, etc.
- ◆House work : meal preparation, cleaning, washing, ironing, purchase of living necessities, taking care of a baby's sister or brother, etc.

●Available Time

8:00am - 8:00pm (As a rule, available on an hourly basis)

●Limit Up to 30 hours / household

●Available Date Everyday (Except Dec.29th to Jan. 3rd)

●How to Apply

Submit at Child Health Section the application form distributed when you received Maternal and Child Health Handbook with a copy of the page where the delivery date or expecting date is written in your Maternal and Child Health Handbook.

Vaccination against rotavirus will start

Rotavirus vaccination is added to regular vaccinations for child

Rotavirus vaccination is to prevent the severe gastroenteritis. Rotavirus is very infective and causes severe diarrhea and vomiting. Children who get rotavirus disease may need to be hospitalized. The occurrence of the diseases related to rotavirus will be decreased from 70% to 80% by having the vaccination.

*There will be possibility that children will be infected with rotavirus just after birth. So it is recommended children to have rotavirus vaccination in their early stage. There are 2 types of rotavirus vaccine and both of them are oral live vaccine. Safety and efficiency are the almost same, but the times and period to have them are different. Please consult at a medical institution when your children have rotavirus vaccination. Once your children have the vaccine, they cannot change the type of vaccine without special reason.

Have you applied for Special Cash Payments related to COVID-19?

The application form for special cash payments was sent to the head of household who are eligible for receiving the special cash payments on Tue, May 19th. If you have not applied for Special Cash Payments yet, please send the application form and necessary documents in the enclosed envelope by post by the deadline.

●Eligibility

◇Those who are registered with Basic Resident Registration System of Onojo City as of Mon, April 27th, 2020 (Base Date)

●Recipient

◇The head of household that eligible persons belong to

●Amount of Special Cash Payments

Cash payment of 100,000 yen per each eligible person

*Payment is done only once.

●Deadline of Application Acceptance

The deadline is Thu, Aug. 20th, 2020.

*Application postmarked on Thu, Aug. 20th, 2020 will be deemed valid.

*You cannot receive the cash payments if you send the application form after the deadline.

●How to Apply and Receive

In order to prevent spread of COVID-19 infection, please apply by post. In principle, the payments will be transferred to the bank accounts of the head of household.

Please fill the application form with relevant information, attach copies of 2 documents (a copy of the document to identify the applicant, the head of household, such as Residence Card, Driver's License and a copy of the applicant's bankbook) and send it in the enclosed envelope by post by the deadline.

Watch out for Red Back Spiders and Hornets!

In Onojo City, venomous spiders named Red Back Spider were found in Onojo City and other areas. They are not aggressive. However you will get bitten if you touch them. Their bite is poisonous to people and possible symptoms in case of the bite are localized pain, sweating, having a fever, swelling and redness at the bite site. If you get bitten, please rinse the bite site with water gently and visit a hospital. When you find the spider, please do not touch it. Also, please report when you find them.



Hornets named Vespa Velutina is found the dwelling in Tsushima City, Nagasaki and found in every area in Kyusyu. Its body length is about 2cm. It builds a nest high location in a tree or a building. The nest is on higher and larger than the nest of native hornet. It is said that the symptom of its sting is almost the same as native one. When you find its nest, please contact us. When you expel it, please ask an exterminator.



Be Careful of Appearance of Monkeys

Monkeys appear in the east (Otogana, Otoganahigashi, around Oki) and south (Tsutsujigaoka, Hiranodai, around Ushikubi) areas in Onojo City. An accident that a junior high school student was scratched by the monkey occurred on Wed, July 15th. When you find monkeys, please be careful about the following points.

- ◇Do not see their eyes ◇Do not get close to them ◇Do not run
- ◇Do not scream ◇Do not stimulate them ◇Never feed them
- *Please do not leave vegetables in your fields after harvest.

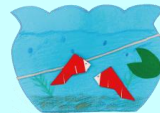

'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office (Returnees and potential contacts call center)' provides consultation service for the persons who may have been infected by novel coronavirus. If you have symptoms listed below, please contact 'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office' immediately before visiting a medical institution. *When you visit the clinic, please wear a mask and avoid using public transportation.

- ◇ Persons who have severe symptoms such as breathing difficulty, severely tired, high fever, etc.
- ◇ Persons whose symptoms are prone to easily get severe such as seniors and those who have chronic diseases and who have symptoms of colds such as fever, cough, etc.
- ◇ Persons who have symptoms of colds and been having symptoms of colds such as fever, cough, etc. (As to persons who have been having these symptoms for 4 days or more, consultation is absolutely required.)
