Application for Using After-school Day Care Center during Winter Holidays (Gakudo Hoikusho)

●Subject Person

Those who fall under all of the following conditions.
Elementary School 1st – 6th grade students whose guardians or house mates are unable to provide supervision for 4 hours or more per day between 8:00am and 5:00pm due to work or other commitments. The guardians or housemates should have 12 days or more with the condition mentioned above per month (excluding Sundays) *Regarding after-hours care and care on Saturdays, there are other conditions.

●Day Care Period

Wed, Dec. 25th, 2019 - Tue, Jan. 7th, 2020
*Closed on Sundays, National Holidays, Sun, Dec. 29th - Fri, Jan. 3rd, 2020

*The day care on Tue, Dec. 24st or/and Wed, Jan. 8th is available upon your request.

●Open Days and Hours

◆Week days 8:00am or After-school - 5:00pm (-7:00pm)*

*Regular care time is until 5:00pm. After-hours care is from 5:00pm to 7:00pm.

*You may apply for after-hours care provided that you apply for regular care.

◆Saturdays 8:00am - 5:00pm

●Day Care Cost (A fee exemption is available)

◆Regular 6,500yen / month

◆After-hours 2,000yen / month

◆Saturday 2,000yen / month

*Payment will be calculated by the day as to December and January.

●How to Apply

Fill in the Application Form* (distributed at After-school Day Care Centers and Education Promotion Section) and submit it together with the guardian's Work Certificate (Kinmu Shomeisho) to Education Promotion Section at Onojo City Office. *You can download from the HP of the city.

●Application Period

Mon, Oct. 28th – Fri, Nov. 15th except for Saturdays and Sundays.

*Application is also acceptable on the following day and time.

Sat, Nov. 9th from 9:30am – 12:30pm

J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert) for Nationwide Transmission Drilling

J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert) for Drilling announced by the Meteorological Agency and the Fire and Disaster Management Agency will be broadcast in Japanese.

*Will be cancelled depending on the weather conditions and a disaster.

●Date Tue, Nov. 5th Around 10:00am

<English Translation of Test Script>

(Ding Dong) "This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. We are going to broadcast J-Alert for a drill" ⇒ [(Sound of Alert) "Earthquake Early Warning.", "This is a huge earthquake.(repeat), "This is a broadcast just for a drill."] ⇒ (Repeated three times) ⇒ "This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. This is the end of the broadcast for the drill." (Ding Dong)

What is "J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert)"?

J-Alert is the disaster information transmission system to inform emergency information such as Earthquake Early Warning, EEW, (緊急地震速報) and Civil Protection Siren (国民保護サイレン).

When occurrence of an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 4 is forecast in Fukuoka Area, Earthquake Early Warning, EEW, (緊急地震速報), which is transmitted from the government, will be broadcast by the disaster information transmission system which is installed in 50 places inside Onojo City.

City's water meter should be replaced with a new one every 8 years. A contractor will visit you to replace the water meter the expiration date of which is coming soon. Houses fall under replacement will be notified by Onojo City until a week before it. While replacing, you cannot use tap-water for about 15 minutes. Please turn off all faucets until replacing work is finished.
