

Fee Exemption

*Please apply for "Fee Exemption" when applying for group medical check-up.
*Please notify to Health Section in advance when taking individual medical check-up at a designated medical institution.

◆**General Medical Check-up:** ◇ a person of a household on welfare: free

◆**Cancer Screening:** Free for the following persons

◇ a person of a household on welfare

◇ a person of a household of city tax-exempt

◇ a person who is aged 65-69 and joins Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (後期高齢者医療)

*Stomach Cancer Screening with a gastrocamera is free of charge only for a person of a household on welfare

*All persons need to pay for Specific Medical Check-up fee and Prostate Gland cancer screening fee.

*We might stop accepting applications before the deadline depending on the situation of applications.

*If you want to use day care for preschoolers, you need to apply beforehand.

Influenza Vaccination, COVID-19 Vaccination for Seniors

● **Subject Person** As of the date of receiving the vaccination, persons who falls under any of the followings

◇ Aged 65 and above ◇ Persons who fit the following criteria: ◆ Aged 60-64 Being judged by a doctor that the person fulfills the diagnosis criteria for the vaccination (Have a disability which extremely restricts actions on one's daily life in any of the following functions; heart, kidney, respiratory, immunity by HIV)

● **Vaccination Period** Wed, Oct. 1st, 2025 - Tue, Mar. 31st, 2026 (except the closed days of medical institutions)

● **Necessary Items** ◇ Documentations by which your address, name, date of birth can be confirmed such as My Number Card ◇ Copy of Physical Disabilities Handbook (equivalent to Level 1) (if you are eligible)

● Co-payment Amount

【Co-payment-exempt】

● The vaccination fee will be exempted for persons in households on tax-exempt or on welfare to show any of the following documents.

◇ Co-payment Maximum Amount Certificate for Long-Term Care Insurance for the Elderly (介護保険負担限度額認定証)

◇ Co-payment Maximum Amount and Standard Co-payment Reduction Certificate for Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (後期高齢者医療限度額適用・標準負担額減額認定証)

◇ Co-Payment Exemption Notice (予防接種自己負担金免除通知書)

【How to apply for Co-Payment Exemption Notice (予防接種自己負担金免除通知書)】

Please never fail to apply for the exemption beforehand and receive the notification before you receive the vaccination. There is no refund after you ended up paying for the vaccination.

*Please visit Onojo City Office, Welfare Service Information Corner (1st Floor) or Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza for the application during opening hours.

Influenza Vaccination, COVID-19 Vaccination for Seniors

● Notes

*Advanced appointment is necessary at a medical institution.

*Group vaccination for COVID-19 will not be held.

*It takes about 2 weeks to develop immunity to the virus after the vaccination.

*The vaccination fee is set by each medical institution for persons other than the subject persons.

*Please consult with your family doctor beforehand whether you can receive the vaccination in case that you are under medical treatment, you have allergies (such as for eggs), or you have Physical Disabilities Handbook.

● Side Effects of the Vaccination

Generally, vaccines help our bodies develop immunity to the viruses that cause illness. Possible side effects from vaccines are pain on the arm you get shot, headache, muscle pain, fatigue, having chills, fever after the vaccination.

There is a rare case, but the life-threatening allergic reaction, anaphylaxis, is one of the side effects caused by the vaccination. If you have any worrisome symptoms, please consult with a family doctor or a medical institution that you had the vaccine.

● Relief System for Injury to Health with Vaccination

Vaccinations can cause health problems (including illness or disability). Although this is extremely rare, the risk cannot be eliminated, and a relief system has been established for this case. For further information, please contact us.
