National Health Insurance System

We will send Notification of Qualification (資格情報のお知らせ: Shikaku-jyoho-no-oshirase) or Certificate to Confirm Qualification (資格確認書: Shikaku-kakunin-sho) of national health insurance from the middle to the end of July.

①Those who have a Myna Health Insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card)

We will send Notification of Qualification (資格情報のお知らせ: Shikaku-jyoho-no-oshirase). When you go to a doctor, please use your Myna Health Insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card). In the case that it is not able to confirm your health insurance qualification online using your Myna Health Insurance Card at medical institutions, please show the Notification of Qualification together with your Myna Health Insurance Card.

*Notification of Qualification is not health insurance card. Please make sure to bring your Myna Health Insurance Card and Notification of Qualification together.

②Those who do not register your My Number Card as your health insurance card

We will send Certificate to Confirm Qualification (資格確認書: Shikaku-kakunin-sho). This document is equivalent to health insurance card. Please use it as your health insurance card and show it at medical institutions.

*Validity of current health insurance card, Certificate to Confirm Qualification (資格確認書: Shikaku-kakunin-sho), is until Fri, Jul. 31st. From Sat, Aug. 1st, please use Myna Health Insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card) or Certificate to Confirm Qualification (資格確認書: Shikaku-kakunin-sho) as your new health insurance card depending on ① or ②.

Older Senior Citizens' Medical System

Certificate to Confirm Qualification (資格確認書: Shikaku-kakunin-sho) (pink color, valid until Jul. 31st, 2027) or Notification of Qualification (資格情報のお知らせ: Shikaku-jyoho-no-oshirase) will be sent to subject persons who enroll in Older Senior Citizens' Medical System in the middle of July. Certificate to Confirm Qualification (資格確認書: Shikaku-kakunin-sho) is equivalent to Older Senior Citizens' Medical card.

If you do not receive it by the end of July, please contact us.

Have you paid the 2nd period of National Health Insurance Tax?

The deadline of payment of the 2nd period of National Health Insurance Tax is Fri, Jul. 31st. Delinquent charge will be charged when the payment is overdue. Please make sure to pay by the deadline.

●Delinquent Charge 9.1% annually for 2026

*From the next day of the deadline to the day a month passes: 2.8% annually

*Making a payment of Municipal and Prefectural Tax and National Health Insurance Tax, etc. by direct debit is convenient. For application, please contact us.

Renewal of City Water Meter

City's water meter should be replaced with a new one every 8 years. A contractor will visit you to replace the water meter that the expiration date is coming soon. If your water meter is due for replacement, you will receive a notice letter at least a week before the replacement starts. While replacing, you cannot use tap-water for about 15 minutes. Please turn off all faucets until replacing work is finished.

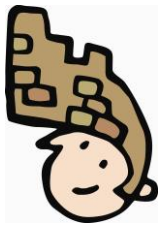

Do you know "Co-payment Maximum Amount and Standard Co-payment Reduction Certificate" (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証)?

If you have enrolled in National Health Insurance and have a Myna Health Insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card) or "Co-payment Maximum Amount (and Standard Co-payment Reduction) Certificate" (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証), you don't have to pay for the amount which exceeds your co-payment maximum amount. When you know your co-payment amount of medical expenses will become high beforehand or a medical institution asks you to apply for this certificate, please take the necessary procedures at National Health Insurance and Pension Section. Also, if you have already obtained this certificate, it will be expired on Fri, Jul. 31st, 2026. If you wish to renew this certificate, please take the procedure for that. A member of household of tax-exempt can get a discount as for meal fee etc. while hospitalized if you have Myna Health insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card) or "Co-payment Maximum Amount (and Standard Co-payment Reduction) Certificate" (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証).

No need to apply

*In the case that you are tax-exempt household and were hospitalized for a long term, 90 days or more in the past year, you need to apply. For further information, please contact us.

◇Those who do not register your My Number Card as your health insurance card

Please apply for the issuance of "Co-payment Maximum Amount (and Standard Co-payment Reduction) Certificate" (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証) on Jul. 1st or after.

*The application might not be necessary for those who are aged 70 or over depending on the income situation. For further information, please contact us.

From Jul. 2026 through Jun. 2027

(My Number Card or Basic Pension Number Notice is also available.)

*In case that the date of employment separation was on and after Dec. 31st, 2024, separation notice, public certificates such as unemployment insurance recipient certificate issued by Hello Work.

●Remarks

*Students cannot make use of this exemption and deferment system. Instead, they may be able to exempt and defer their premium payments through the Student Special Payment System.

*You are required to pay the rest of the premium within 2 years if you receive Three Quarter Exemption, A Half Exemption and A Quarter Exemption. If you don't pay the rest of the amount during the period, the amount you will receive pension benefits will be decreased.

Stomach Cancer Screening

Stomach Cancer Screening with a gastrocamera will be offered at the medical institutions designated by Onojo City from July.

● **Subject Person** Onojo residents aged 50 or older who did not get Stomach Cancer Screening with a gastrocamera last fiscal year

*Age: As of Mar. 31st, 2027

*Stomach Cancer Screening is held every 2 years.

*Consultation ticket was sent around the end of May to Onojo residents aged 50 and 60 who did not get Stomach Cancer Screening with a gastrocamera last fiscal year or those who got the Stomach Cancer Screening with a gastrocamera in FY2024.

The letter is written in Japanese only.

*As for Onojo residents who could not get the Stomach Cancer Screening last fiscal year and would like to get the screening this fiscal year, we issue consultation ticket. Please contact us.

● **Consultation Period** Wed, Jul. 1st, 2026 - Sun, Feb. 28th, 2027

*Consultation reservation is available from Mon. Jun. 8th.

● **Fee** 3,000yen *need a consultation ticket issued by the city

*Household on welfare is free. Please show certificate of public assistance at the designated medical institution.

● **Necessary Item**

"Traffic Safety Campaign" from July 10th to July 19th

● **Drunk Driving Elimination**

If you consume any kind of alcohol, do not operate any automobile, bicycle or motorbike. Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law, and severely punished. Additionally, providing alcohol to someone you know who will drive and being a passenger in a vehicle in which you know the driver has consumed alcohol are also punishable by law. If you are drinking, don't drive, if you're driving, don't drink.



● **Traffic Accident Prevention**

When you drive, please pay careful attention to pedestrians, especially children and elderly people, and make an effort to prevent traffic accident.

● **Promotion of Safe and Proper Bicycle and Electric Scooter Use**

When you ride on a bicycle and an electric scooter, do not ride under the influence of alcohol and do not operate your mobile phone while riding. Please wear a helmet and follow safety rules to prevent an accident. If you have an accident, there will be a case that you are required to pay compensation to a victim. To protect you and a victim, it is mandatory for cyclists to buy bicycle insurance from Oct. 2020.

5 Rules of Safety Bicycle Use

When you ride on a bicycle and an electric scooter, please follow the 5 Rules of Safety Bicycle Use to prevent an accident.

① In principle, ride on the road.

Ride on the left side of the road.

Riding on the sidewalk is allowed only in exceptional cases.

On sidewalks, yield to pedestrians.

② Stop at intersections, follow traffic lights and check safety.

③ Turn on headlights at night.

④ Riding while under the influence of alcohol is prohibited.

⑤ Wear a helmet.

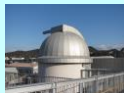

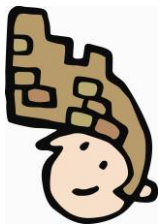
