Declaration of Residential Tax and National Health Insurance Tax

●Subject Person

Persons who live in Onojo City as of January 1st, 2026 and fall under any of the following:

- ◇Who had income in 2025
- ◇Who is head of a household who has enrolled in the National Health Insurance.(Kokumin Kenko Hoken)
- ◇Who has enrolled in Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (Koki Koreisha Iryo Hoken)
- ◇Who has no income, but needs a tax certificate such as a tax exemption certificate
*if you are employed, please ask your employer if you are a subject person or not.
*If you submit your final tax return document, you don't need to declare.



Do you know “Co-payment Maximum Amount and Standard Co-payment Reduction Certificate” (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証)?

If you have enrolled in National Health Insurance and have a Myna Health Insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card) or “Co-payment Maximum Amount (and Standard Co-payment Reduction) Certificate” (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証), you don't have to pay for the amount which exceeds your co-payment maximum amount. When you know your co-payment amount of medical expenses will become high beforehand or a medical institution asks you to apply for this certificate, please take the necessary procedures at National Health Insurance and Pension Section. Also, if you have already obtained this certificate, it will be expired on Fri, Jul. 31st, 2026. If you wish to renew this certificate, please take the procedure for that. A member of household of tax-exempt can get a discount as for meal fee etc. while hospitalized if you have Myna Health insurance Card (My Number Card with the function of health insurance card) or “Co-payment Maximum Amount (and Standard Co-payment Reduction) Certificate” (限度額適用 (・標準負担額減額) 認定証). If you want to renew these certificates, please apply on Wed, Jul. 1st or after.







Shiawase (Happiness) E-Library

You can read e-books for free anytime, anywhere on the internet using your personal computer, smartphone, or tablet device. You are responsible for your own connection fees.

What is "Shiawase E-Library"?

It is an e-library jointly operated by four cities and towns: Onojo City, Kasuya Town, Shime Town, and Shingu Town. We deliver "happiness" to our residents through reading.

The e-library is very convenient!

◇ You can borrow and return e-books without visiting the library. You don't need to worry about forgetting to return them, as there is an automatic return function.

◇ You can change the font size and color of the text.

◇ Some books also have an audio reading function.

◇ In the usage support site for visually impaired people, you can search, borrow, and browse books that are compatible with audio reading software.

Rules for use

● You can borrow up to three items.

● The borrowing period is 15 days.

● You can extend the borrowing period once if there are no upcoming reservations.

● You can reserve up to three items.

● The reservation holding period is 8 days.

*Please check your reservation status on My Page, as there will be no notification when the reserved e-book becomes available.

Eligibility

◇ Residents, commuters, and students of Onojo City

◇ Those who live, commute to, or study in Onojo City and have a valid "Madokapia library user card" can use the e-library.

*If you live in the city and have a valid card, you can use it immediately.

*If you commute to or study in the city, please bring your card and a certificate that confirms your workplace or study in the city to the Madokapia library.

Search for documents

Once you find a book, you can borrow it.

④ Borrow


