## Acceptance of Application for Nursery School Enrollment for the new academic year to begin

If you are planning to use authorized nursery school, a small-sized nursing establishment or an authorized "Kodomo-En" (nursery section) for the new academic year (from Apr.1<sup>st</sup>, 2026 - Mar.31<sup>st</sup>, 2027), please submit an enrollment application to Childrearing Support Section of Onojo City. Even if you once applied for the academic year 2025 and your child is now being taken care at a nursery school, a small-sized nursing establishment or an authorized "Kodomo-En", you are required to take the same procedure again.

\*"Small-sized nursing establishment" will accept infants aged 0-2 as of Apr.1<sup>st</sup>, 2026 and Authorized "Kodomo-En" (nursery section) will accept infants aged 0-5 as of Apr.1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. The application period and method will be same as the ones of authorized nursery schools. "Small-sized nursing establishment" is a nursing facility which is authorized by Onojo City and takes care of up to 19 infants. Authorized "Kodomo-En" is a combined facility of nursing and education which is authorized by Fukuoka Prefecture.

### ●Distribution Start Date

### ●Eligible Infant

An infant aged 51 days or older as of the day of enrollment and whose guardian(s) is unable to take care of the infant due to any of the following reasons.

- ◇Working outside the house or at home
- ◇Sickness
- ◇Nursing sick person
- ◇Receiving Education etc.

### ●Application Acceptance Period

#### ◇Enrollment in April

**Starting Date:** Tue, Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>

**Closing Date:** 1<sup>st</sup> Period: Sat, Dec. 27<sup>th</sup> by 12:30pm

2<sup>nd</sup> Period: Sat, Feb. 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026 by 12:30pm

\*The 2<sup>nd</sup> period application will be arranged **only when** there are authorized nursery school, small-sized nursing establishment or authorized "Kodomo-En" which is still able to accept applications after the 1<sup>st</sup> period application. (Submitting the application within the 1<sup>st</sup> period is highly recommended.)

## Acceptance of Application for Nursery School Enrollment for the new academic year to begin

### ◇Enrollment in May and later

Please submit the documents 2 months prior to the start of your child care (by 4:30pm). Application is closed on the last day of every month. In case that the city office is closed on the last day of the month, please apply by the open day before the last day.

e.g. Start in May ⇒ Submission by the end of March by 4:30pm

- ◇In the case of enrollment in February or March 2027, the deadline is Mon, Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026 by 4:30pm.

### ●How to Apply

Please visit Childrearing Support Section and submit the application form and necessary documents.


### ●Remarks

- ◆Not all the applications will be admitted in the case of exceeding the quota of each nursery school, small-sized nursing establishment or authorized "Kodomo-En". Also, the admission of an infant is decided in accordance with the degree of necessity of child care, not on first-come, first-served basis.
- ◆Make sure to fill out the application form for academic year 2026.
- ◆Before submitting your application, please make sure to visit all nursery schools you have chosen together with your child. Otherwise, your application may not be accepted.  
\*You make an appointment with each nursery school by yourself.
- ◆In the case of failure to submit necessary documents such as a certificate of employment, a certificate of childrearing leave or submission of incomplete documents, your application will not be accepted.
- ◆As *Narashi Hoiku* (Temporary short time day care for getting accustomed to a new environment) is included in the regular day care period, please apply by the deadline of the month in which *Narashi Hoiku* will be done.
- ◆Application submission deadline for March 2026 is Sat, Dec. 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025 by 12:30pm.



## Welfare Services for Single-Parent Families

Please make use of the following services if you are eligible.

### Single Parent Medical Service

● **Eligible Person** \*excluding persons on welfare.

◇ Single mother household ◇ Single father household ◇ Child with no parents

\*Income restrictions apply.

\*Child...from the day your child enters an elementary school until the end of the fiscal year when your child turns 18 years old. (Infant Medical Service takes priority over this medical service for a child who has not yet entered an elementary school)

\*People who are under the protection of Public Assistance Act will not be subjected.

\*In case that a spouse has not been able to work for a long time due to his or her disability, the household is regarded as a single-parent family.

### ● Subsidy

Equivalent amount of your co-payment amount covered by your health insurance will be aided.

\*You might be required to pay a partial amount.

\*If you do not have Single Parent Medical Service Card, please consult us.

## Welfare Services for Single-Parent Families

Please make use of the following services if you are eligible.

### Child-Rearing Allowance

● **Eligible Person** Mothers, fathers or those who are substitute for such mothers and fathers who provide care for their children who fall under any of the following conditions. \*In principle, this allowance will be paid until the following March 31<sup>st</sup> after the child turns 18 years old or children aged under 20 as to children with disabilities.

◇ Child whose parents annulled their marriage <Divorce>

◇ Child whose father (mother) passed away <Death>

◇ Child whose father (mother) has a disability corresponding to a level equivalent to that stated in the relevant enforcement regulations

◇ Child who has been abandoned for 1 year or more by his/her father(mother)

◇ Child whose mother has been unmarried since childbirth etc.

\*The allowance is not paid in any of the following conditions.

◇ The relevant child and his/her father (mother) or rearer don't reside in Japan. (No address registered in Japan)

◇ The relevant child stays at a child welfare facility.

◇ The child's father (mother) or rearer earns more than the specified amount. etc.

### ● Monthly Amount (Maximum Amount)

◇ 46,690 yen per child

\*In the case of having two children, 11,030 yen will be added.

\*Monthly payment will be reduced depending on the income of the child's father (mother) or rearer.


### ● Payment Month odd month

\*Allowance for previous 2 months will be paid.

### Discount for Commuting Pass (JR only)

A person of the household which is receiving Child-Rearing Allowance can purchase a commuting pass of JR with 30% discount.

## Welfare Services for Single-Parent Families

### Day-to-day Living Support for Single-Parent Families

In the case of temporary necessity of child care service, a day-to-day living support service staff will visit a single-parent family.

#### ●Eligible Person

- ◇Single parent living in Onojo City who raises child/ren under 20 years old and falls under any of the following reasons.
- ◇Widow living in Onojo City who raises child/ren under 20 years old and falls under any of the following reasons.
  - ① Receiving education or other programs to help them become independent, Job hunting
  - ② Social reasons such as illness, taking care of family members, accidents, ceremonial occasions such as marriage or burial, working overtime, business trip, participation in public events held at school and so on.
  - ③ Working overtime or other reasons related your work (Service for a parent who is bringing up a preschooler or an child/children who is/are attending elementary school.)

●Details ◇Taking care of an infant/infants ◇Serving meals ◇Taking care of an applicant ◇Purchasing daily living necessities etc.

#### ●Hours

- ①, ② within 80 hours per reason, within 160 hours in total a year
- ③ within 20 hours per month, within 120 hours in total a year

●Charge varies by income of the applicant

#### ●Remarks

There are other supporting services for a single parent such as Subsidy for Self-support Education and Training Programs and Subsidy for High-level Skill Development Training Programs and so on. For further information, please contact us.

## Application for Special Child-Rearing Allowance

In the case that you are eligible to receive this allowance and have not received it yet, please apply for it. You will be able to receive it from the following month of filing application provided that your situation meets the requirement and conditions of this allowance. For details such as application method, please contact us.

●Subject Person parents or rearers who are raising children under 20 years old with moderate to severe physical or intellectual disabilities.

\*The allowance is not paid in any of the following conditions.

◇The relevant child and his/her father (mother) or rearer don't reside in Japan. (No address registered in Japan)

◇The relevant child can receive public pension due to his/her disability.

\*Welfare Allowance for Children with Disabilities is not pension.

◇The relevant child stays at a child welfare facility.

◇The child's father (mother) or rearer has income more than the specified amount. etc.

#### ●Monthly Amount

◇1<sup>st</sup> Grade: 56,800 yen per child ◇2<sup>nd</sup> Grade: 37,830 yen per child

●Payment Month Apr. (Dec.-Mar.) • Aug. (Apr.-Jul.) • Nov. (Aug.-Nov.)



The deadline of the 6<sup>th</sup> period of National Health Insurance Tax is Mon, Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>. Delinquent charge will be charged when the payment of the tax is overdue. Please make sure to pay by the deadline.

● **Delinquent Charge** 8.7% annually for 2025

\*From the next day of the deadline to the day a month passes: 2.4% annually

## Regarding Special Measures against HPV Vaccination to Prevent Uterine Cervical Cancer (until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026)

Catch-up vaccination for HPV routine vaccination is offered to women who missed the opportunity of the vaccination due to the suspension of the active promotion for HPV vaccination to provide equal vaccination opportunity. Women born between April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1997 and April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009, who received at least one dose during the catch-up vaccination period (April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 – March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025) can receive the remaining doses as part of the routine vaccination schedule until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

### ●Vaccine Type

- ◇Cervarix (bivalent)
- ◇Gardasil (quadrivalent)
- ◇Silgard (9-valent)

### ●Number of doses 3 times

\*Please receive the remaining doses.

\*Intervals of 3 months or more are required between 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and 3<sup>rd</sup> dose.

### ●Venue medical institutions designated by the city

\*If you have HPV vaccination out of Fukuoka Prefecture, you need to apply in advance.

### ●Necessary Items Maternal and Child Health Handbook

\*Questionnaire is available at medical institutions.

\*Please have the vaccine after understanding the effectiveness and side effects.




